Florida	HCR's: 703, 693, 7055, 7057.	BBA, TML, equal application of Law, line-item veto.	4/2/24	Redundant. BBA & TML had already passed in 2014 and 2016 respectively. New applications are insignificant, bringing FL's total applications on record to 15!
